Guidelines - Professional Practices Grant

The National Kindergarten Alliance announces Professional Practices Grants up to \$500 each. The purpose of the grant is to encourage developmentally appropriate practices to benefit current kindergarten children. Applications for Professional Practices Grants are available only to current individual members of the National Kindergarten Alliance in good standing who have been members for at least one year. Last year's recipients will not be considered.

- Please limit your proposal to no more than four (4) pages.

1. Title of the project

2. Statement of need

What is the need or problem addressed by the project?

3. Goals and Objectives

What are the goals of the project? How will it improve and enhance the existing school program? How does it benefit children?

4. Project Description/Activities/Strategies

Outline the action steps of the project including preparatory research (Bibliography, resources), student activities and materials involved.

5. Time line

Provide a time line for the project.

6. Evaluation

Describe in detail how you will evaluate the goals and objectives of the project. How will you determine the results or benefits of the project to students? Include a rough draft sample of your evaluation document.

7. Impact beyond one classroom

Can this project be replicated or extended? How will you share this project with other kindergarten teachers?

8. Budget

Itemize the project costs i.e.: materials, equipment and supplies.

9. Resume/Educational Background

10. Two Current Professional Letters of Reference
